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CITIZENSHIP THURSDAY!

REQUIRED DOCUMENTS AND INFORMATION FOR THE CITIZENSHIP APPLICATION

- Passport/Passports** for the last **5 YEARS** (current and expired)
- Legal Permanent Residence** card
- Social Security** card
- Money order/Check/Credit Card** for \$725
- Addresses** – List of **ALL** the addresses where you have lived in the last **5 YEARS**, including when you lived at each address (month and year)
- Employers and Schools** – List of **ALL** your employers and/or schools in the last **5 YEARS**, including the addresses, dates when you worked/studied in each place, and your occupation
- Spouse** – Date of marriage, date of birth and the name of his/her employer. If s/he is a Legal Permanent Resident, alien (residency) number is needed. If current spouse is a naturalized American citizen, date and place of naturalization (copy of naturalization certificate). Current marriage certificate, divorce, annulment decree, or death certificate of former spouse.
- Previous marriages** – If you or your current spouse have been previously married (*it does not matter when or where*), you will need the name, date of birth, country of birth, dates of marriage and divorce for **ALL** previous spouse(s).
- Children** – Information of **ALL** your children and step-children (it does not matter where they live, their age, or if they are deceased), including their dates of birth, current addresses, and alien (residency) number (if applicable)
- Certificate of disposition issued by a court or the police** – If you have ever been arrested, cited, detained, or given a summons, for any reason (including MTA or personal tickets), you will need the certificates of disposition for **ALL** of these arrests/tickets
- Selective Service registration number** – If you are male and lived in the United States between the ages of 18 and 26 as a Legal Permanent Resident
- Taxes** – If you are applying on the basis of marriage to a U.S. citizen, bring the IRS tax return transcript for the last 3 years with your name and your spouse's name. Call (800) 829-1040 for more information.

WARNING

Let us know if **any** of the following conditions apply to you

- In the last 5 years, you have traveled abroad for more than 180 days, or, within one year, you spent more than 180 days abroad
- You have *ever* been arrested, cited, detained, or given a summons, for any reason (including MTA, personal, or pending tickets)
- You have resided in another country since you became a Legal Permanent Resident
- You have never paid taxes, you owe taxes, or you have paid them as a non-resident
- You have been detained by an immigration officer, or you have had a deportation or exclusion process
- You owe child support
- You are male and lived in the United States between the ages of 18 and 26, but you never registered with the Selective Service
- You have registered to vote or voted in an election in the United States

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
